# Updating Certificates for Document Compliance for Portugal

# 1 Introduction

You already use SAP Cloud Platform Integration to establish the communication with external systems and transfer to them the electronic documents you have created using the SAP Document Compliance for Portugal.

This guide shows you the steps to update the certificates provided by the Portuguese tax authorities in your solution.

## 2 Uploading Key Pairs and Private Keys

### Context

You deploy the key pairs to the SAP Cloud Platform Integration tenants. You need separated key pairs for testing and production environments.

### Procedure

1. Request the private keys for test and productive environments: `edocumentportugaltestdgita.p12` and `edocumentportugalproddgita.p12`. For that, open a customer incident under the `CA-GTF-CSC-EDO-PT` component.
2. Optional: We recommend to back up the key pairs currently in use. In the *Keystore*, go to **Operations** **Keystore**, select one file and choose **Action** **Download**. Alternatively, you can back up the whole keystore by choosing the *Back Up* button in the same screen.
3. Delete the old key pairs. In the *Keystore*, go to **Operations** **Keystore**, select one file (for example, `edocumentportugaltestdgita`) and choose **Action** **Delete**. Repeat it for the production and test key pairs you need to replace.
4. Upload the new private key in the *Keystore* app. Go to **Operations View** **Keystore** **Add** **Key Pair**.

You must upload the `edocumentportugaltestdgita.p12` and `edocumentportugalproddgita.p12` files to the keystore of the tenant. Create the alias for the key pair according to the following naming convention:

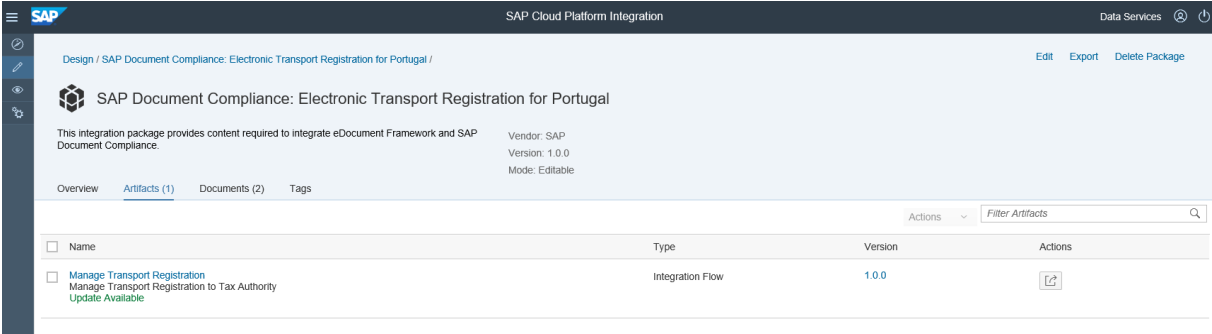
Value	Description
<code>edocumentportugaltestdgita</code>	Test environment
<code>edocumentportugalproddgita</code>	Production environment

# 3 Updating Public Key

You upload the iFlow with the new key pairs and the system automatically updates the public key.

## Procedure

Update the iFlow with the new private keys. Go to your implementation package. In the *Artifact* tab, select the *Manage Transport Registration* artifact (it shows "Update Available") choose **Actions** **Update**. The public key is automatically updated when you update the artifact.
